

# Ohio FAFSA Data Service

The FAFSA Data Service is a service that enables secure access to student-level FAFSA application submission data for high school counselors in public districts and community schools. The service was first made available in 2016 as part of Ohio's FAFSA Completion Initiative and is managed by Ohio K12 Help in cooperation with the Ohio Department of Higher Education (ODHE). The features and access levels include the following:
