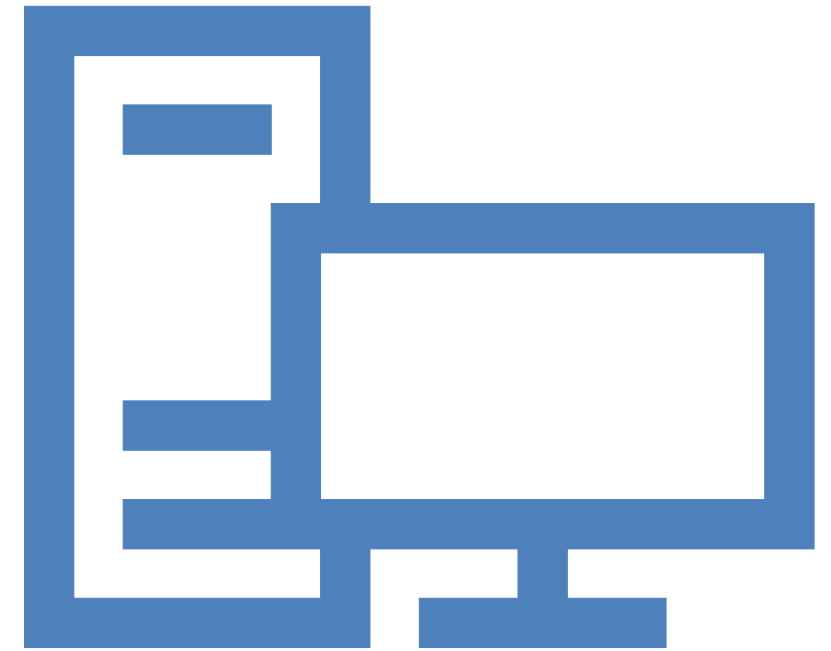
Eligible Expenses

- Public wi-fi
- Mobile public wi-fi
- In-home internet
- Take home hotspots
- Cellular enabled devices



Devices

- Able to connect to the internet on its own
- Must include cellular plan
- ONE device per STUDENT



Ineligible Expenses

- NO tablets, laptops or Chromebooks with only wi-fi or wired access
- NO traditional cell phones
- NO ancillary equipment
- NO payroll
- NO indirect costs

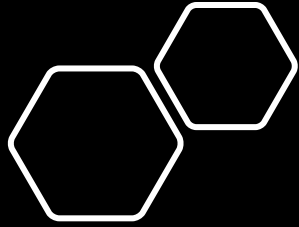

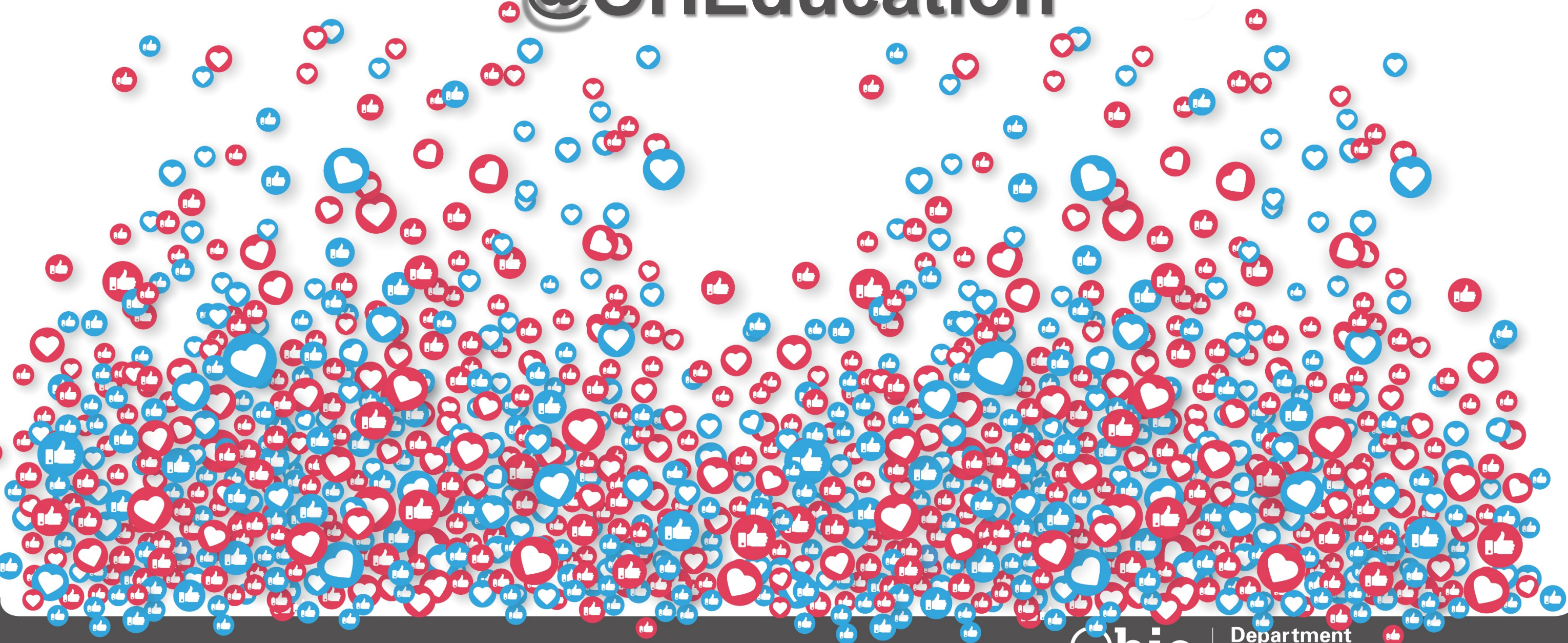
